

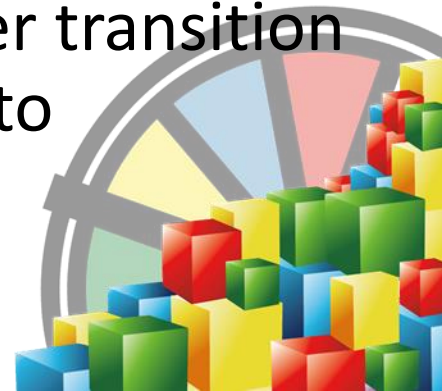


# EXCITING TIMES
