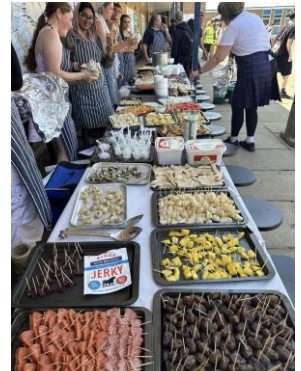
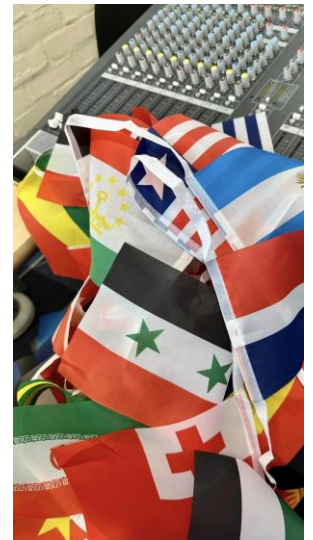


Culture Day 2023 – 16th June – Together as One

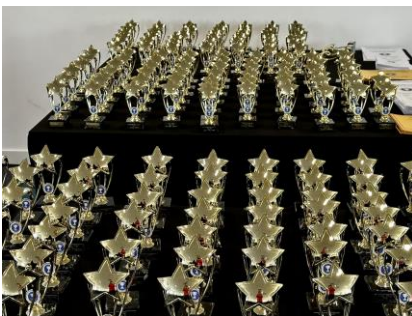


As you are aware we feel incredibly privileged to have been selected as one of three schools to partner with the Aston Martin Aramco Cognizant, Formula One™ Team.

The Radcliffe Art and Graphics team would like to invite the Yr11 and Yr13 Art & Graphics 2023 leavers to an exhibition of their work.

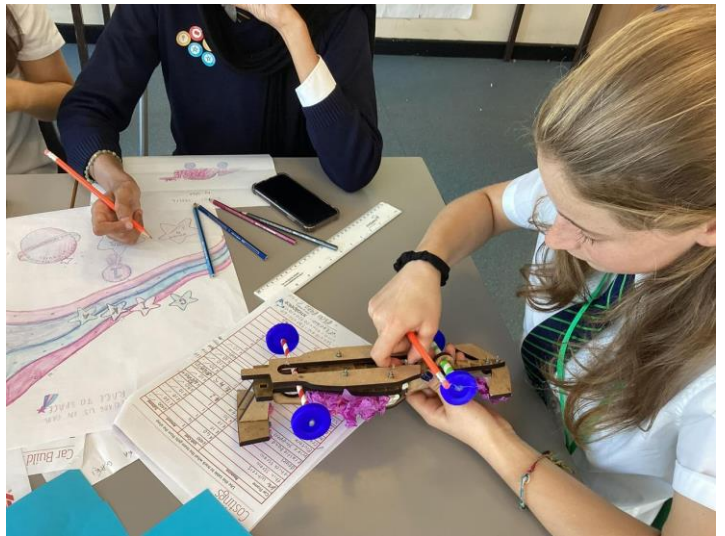
The exhibition will be on Thursday 29th June 5-8pm in the main hall. Entry through the main hall entrance to the left of reception.
