Annie attended the awards on Wednesday night in London and her image was given a commended award and Annie's image appears in this year's book.

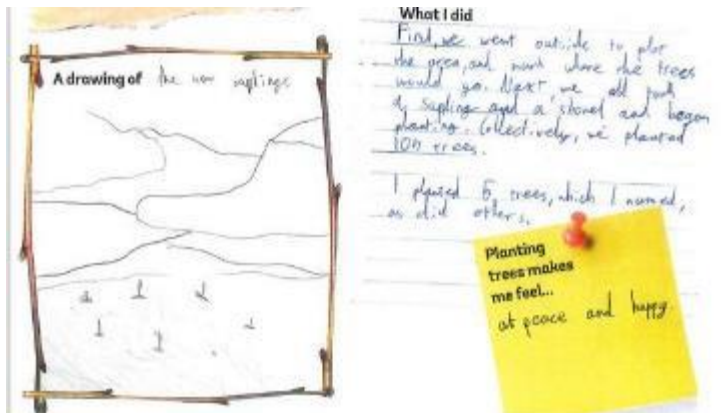
There were 17,000 entries and just 93 images made it into the book! All of us are incredibly proud of you Annie, well done !!!
