Buses*	Bus access is on the Stratford Road or via the bus terminal in Wolverton Town Centre, a few minutes walk from the school.
Rail*	Rail access is via the Wolverton Train station which is a few minutes walk from the school along the Stratford Road and into the Christchurch Grove entrance.
Roads*	There are multiple road access points to the school from Addington Avenue, Aylesbury Street West, and Christchurch Grove. The V5 and V6 provide easy access from further afield.
Walking Routes*	The school has easy access due to its position in Wolverton either using the Redways or via the streets that link to each of our three entrances.
Cycling Routes*	Redways run past the entrances to the site so provide easy access to the school. The school also has easy safe access via the local road infrastructure.
