Admissions E-Data Collection:

You will receive a separate email from our Admissions Team via our online admissions portal. This email will be sent from <u>admin@applicaa.com</u> (Please **DO NOT** send any emails to this address).

In order to complete the registration process for your child we need you login via the link on the email and enter the specific username and password. We have tried to make this process as simple as possible, by putting together an electronic data collection form for you to complete. This form **MUST** be completed for each Year 7 child transitioning from Primary School to Secondary in September.
